Must-haves:

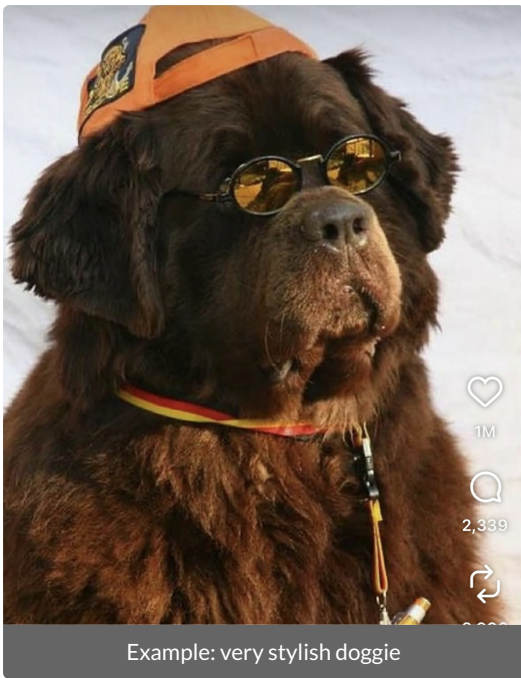
- A mirror big enough for both of you to admire yourselves
